



# 20,000

The number of satellites in space should quintuple by 2030 if commercial companies hit their target - **20,000 launches are already planned for the next 10 years**




In 63 years of space activities, more than 5,500 rockets have been launched. **Over the next decade, up to 1,100 satellites could be launched every year**, by an ever-increasing number of actors.

# 130 million

130 million of space debris are currently in orbit, twice as many as **20 years ago**. This has increased the probability of **collision** with satellites by a **factor 8**.

# 1 trillion

The global space industry could generate revenue of more than **\$1 trillion in 2040, up from \$350 billion currently**.

**50% of the projected growth of the global space economy is expected to come from satellite broadband**, which offers important opportunities to drive down the cost of data as demand explodes.
